peating itself in different forms all across this country and Canada.

"We're struggling here. We have a group of about 10 believers - strong in the Adventist and the Three Angels Message - but also have taken that step further and are celebrating the holy days.

"When we first discovered the truth about the feasts and festivals I made day mornings, and neither feels right. The rabbi is very vocal about literal Israel and politics often enter his sermons, which makes at least one of our families uncomfortable to the point of not wanting to attend. The Adventist church we've been attending for years now has become so worldly that several of our families don't want to attend. We're stuck. Do you have any

coming of Christ, have been presented before me again and again to illustrate the position of the people of God in their experience before the second coming of Christ..." SM Vol. 1, p. 406.

This is a rather scary thought. God's professed people were in full-blown apostasy just before Jesus' first coming, all the while thinking that they were doing His will. What this means is that the Gospels and the *Desire of Ages* are prophecy books. If we want to know what God's professed people will be like just before the Second Coming, take a look at what His professed people were like at His First Coming.

"Among many of the professing followers of Christ there is the same pride, formalism, and selfishness, the same spirit of oppression, that held so large a place in the Jewish heart." AA p. 431. "As the light and life of men was rejected by the ecclesiastical authorities in the days of Christ, so it has been rejected in every succeeding generation. Again and again the history of Christ's withdrawal from Judea has been repeated. When the Reformers preached the word of God. they had no thought of separating themselves from the established church; but the religious leaders would not tolerate the light, and those that bore it were forced to seek another class, who were longing for the truth. In our day few of the professed followers of the Reformers are actuated by their spirit. Few are listening for the voice of God, and ready to accept truth in whatever guise it may be presented. Often those who follow in the steps of the Reformers are forced to turn away from the churches they love, in order to declare the plain teaching of the word of God. And many times those who are seeking for light are by the same teaching obliged to leave the church of their fathers, that they may render obedience." DA 232.2

WHERE DO WE WORSHIP?

We have been asked this question many times by people who are distressed over the apostasies that they are seeing in the church and by those who have been disfellowshipped for following in the footsteps of Jesus by observing His holy days as He Himself did. We believe that the Seventh-day Adventist Church was raised up by God for the purpose of repairing the breaches in His Word. Therefore, we tell everyone to stay in the SDA Church as long as possible and be a positive witness for Him, both in and outside the church, unless: 1) You have children who are being corrupted by the apostasies in the church and there is no other local SDA Church to go to where they will not be corrupted. A word to the wise if you have children. A number of years ago, when our children were teenagers, we were told that the youth were being taken to meetings away from the church and away from their parents where they could be led contrary to what faithful, SDA parents believe. We did not believe them, so we determined to go ourselves to the next such meeting. We were absolutely shocked by what we saw and found out we had been told the truth. 2) You yourself are being corrupted by the apostasies in the church and are not yet strong enough spiritually to stand strong in such an environment. 3) You have been told to leave because you are following Jesus' example in all things. The only time a church should tell someone to leave is if they are engaging in open sin that they refuse to repent of. Unfortunately, this rule is being broken. We are very sad over this state of affairs. So, if we have to leave the church because of one of the above three reasons, where do we go? This is the question that we have given much thought to. We have already been told that we should form small companies

for the purpose of evangelizing. "The formation of small companies as a basis of Christian effort has been presented to me by One who cannot err." Testimonies, vol. 7, pp. 21, 22. So, why not form an SDA Branch Sabbath School in your home?

WHAT SHOULD BE OUR ATTITUDE?

What should be our attitude towards the apostasies that we see in the church? "Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and set a mark upon the foreheads of the men that sigh and that cry for all the abominations that be done in the midst thereof (Ezekiel 9:4)...At the time when the danger and depression of the church are greatest, the little company who are standing in the light will be sighing and crying for the abominations that are done in the land. But more especially will their prayers arise in behalf of the church because its members are doing after the manner of the world...The class who do not feel grieved over their own spiritual declension, nor mourn over the sins of others, will be left without the seal of God...The seal of God will be placed upon the foreheads of those only who sigh and cry for the abominations done in the land." Testimony Volume 5, "The Seal of God," pp. 207-216.

WHERE DOES GOD WANT US TO PUT OUR TITHES AND OFFERINGS?

From time to time we have someone approach us with this question. We have given this question much thought ourselves as we earnestly desire to do God's will. We believe that the answer to this question is found in the chapter entitled "The

Seal of God" in Testimonies, Volume 5. God seals His people just before the time of trouble ("Just before we entered it [the time of trouble], we all received the seal of the living God." 7BC 968, 1846, or Last Day Events p. 228), so this chapter is describing the last generation within the church. We urge you to read this entire chapter in Testimonies Volume 5, pp. 207-216, to see the complete picture. In this chapter Ellen White gives a very accurate description of God's church just before the end. Here are a few of the quotes in this chapter. "At the time when the danger and depression of the church are greatest, the little company who are standing in the light will be sighing and crying for the abominations that are done in the land. But more especially will their prayers arise in behalf of the church because its members are doing after the manner of the world...These sighing, crying ones had been holding forth the words of life; they had reproved, counseled, and entreated. Some who had been dishonoring God repented and humbled their hearts before Him. But the glory of the Lord had departed from Israel; although many still continued the forms of religion, His power and presence were lacking...Here we see that the church—the Lord's sanctuary was the first to feel the stroke of the wrath of God. The ancient men, those to whom God had given great light and who had stood as guardians of the spiritual interests of the people, had betrayed their trust." This quote says the following: 1) The little company, a minority in the church, will be standing in the light. 2) The majority of the church are doing after the manner of the world, causing the glory of the Lord to depart from them. 3) The ancient men (church leaders) have betrayed their trust.

The picture that is painted here is

that at the end there are only two groups in God's church, the small company who are standing in the light, and the majority. The small company who are standing in the light are God's faithful ones who go through to the end and who finish the work. The majority in God's church will apostasize and go the wrong way. So who do we give our tithes and offerings to? The small company standing in the light, or the majority? We think the answer is obvious. We are told to put everything we own on the altar and ask God to guide us as to what we should sell, when we should sell, and when we should put the money into the gospel. Also pray for guidance as to where you should put God's money and we know that He will answer your prayer.
